West Texas Energy Consortium Launches New Membership Plan

Conference discounts, members-only networking events, and more announced

West Texas – Friday, September 26, 2014: The West Texas Energy Consortium (WTxEC) has unveiled a tiered membership approach to better serve participants in 49 counties across West Texas. Formerly structured as an open subscribership with strictly email distribution benefits, WTxEC has added three additional paid membership levels with perks such as conference and workshop discounts, members-only networking events, and website access to an internal resource library featuring contact lists, reports, meeting minutes, and more.

There will continue to be a free subscription option for email distribution that is open to current and future participants. Paid membership dues for individuals start at only \$50 annually. Multiple subscriber memberships are available for nonprofit/community partners at a cost of \$150 annually and will include additional benefits like postings to the WTxEC event calendar. Businesses are also able to purchase multiple subscriber memberships for \$200 with the included benefits of reduced price ad space and discounted affiliate trainings.

Chairman Victor Carrillo, former Texas Railroad Commissioner, says, "West Texas is experiencing unprecedented long term oil and gas growth that will contribute to energy independence. With this membership initiative, we seek to ensure that our Consortium is sustainable, so that we can make a positive impact for years to come."
